

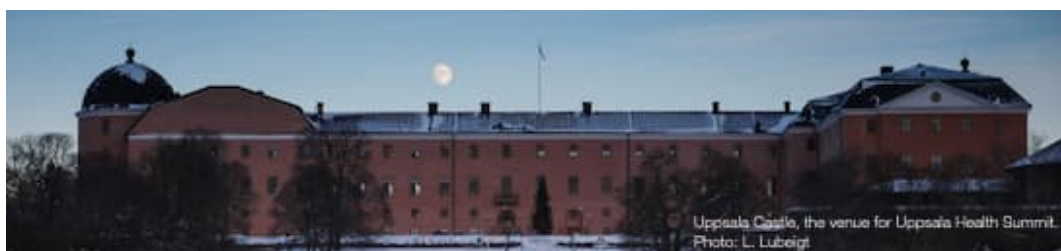

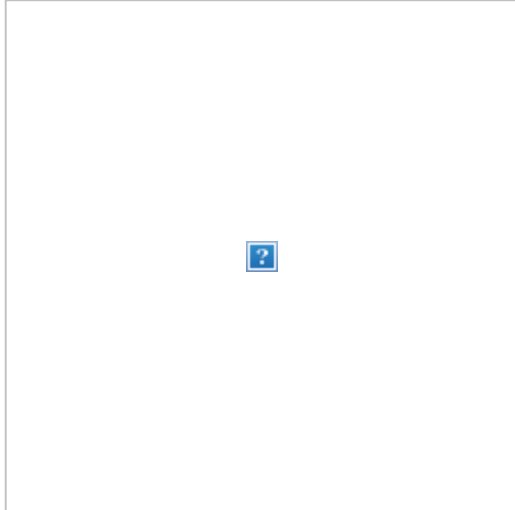


physical health in mind.
