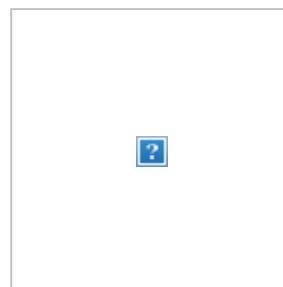
Plenum Programme highlights 2018
